




Guided by stringent compliance to COVID-19 Shipyard Health and Safety protocols, N-KOM safely delivered a total of 135 Marine, Offshore and Industrial Engineering projects in 2020.

In the first quarter of 2021, N-KOM continued its momentum of project deliveries amidst the COVID-19 Vaccination programme. With strict compliance to Health and Safety protocols reinforced, the Yard's team of technical experts successfully completed 33 projects comprising Tankers, LNG carriers, a range of other marine vessels, as well as Offshore and Industrial Engineering jobs.

### Major works completed for LNG Al Deebel

N-KOM recently completed drydocking and repairs of LNG carrier Al Deebel for long-time client MOL LNG Transport (Europe). In addition to routine repairs, renewals and overhauls carried out, the vessel was also retrofitted with a Ballast Water Treatment System (BWTS) and underwent Cargo Tank Membrane repairs.

N-KOM also successfully performed the following scope of work for the first time for an LNG carrier:

- Overhauling of Main Circulating Pumps 1 & 2
- Machining of Wear Ring seats
- Overhauling of all 4 Crane Winches

The project was executed in a safe and timely manner in compliance with all COVID-19 precautions.

#### Another successful vessel conversion

N-KOM has successfully completed the conversion of a Platform Supply Vessel (PSV) to Well Stimulation Vessel (WSV) for Schlumberger and Milaha Ship Management. This is the fourth conversion project undertaken by N-KOM for our long-time repeat client Schlumberger, indicating their confidence and satisfaction in our capabilities and ability to deliver high-quality projects on time.

The conversion project entailed the following:

- Prefabrication & installation of approximately 850 Spools
- 15,000 diameter inches of Weld joints
- 10,200 meters of Power and Control cables
- 30 tons of Outfitting jobs for Platforms & Walkways
- Installation of 47 equipment for Well Stimulation plant on deck

The conversion project was completed safely and on schedule.






